## **Grundy County Landfill Commission**

Minutes of the Meeting held on Thursday, July 11, 2024 Location: Grundy County Landfill/CCC

The meeting was called to order at 6:42 by the Chairman. The minutes of the June meeting were approved as read via a motion by Strobehn, seconded by Juchems.

The Commissioners approved payment of the bills totaling \$6154.13 for the Citizen's Convenience Center and \$169.70 for the Landfill on a motion by Metz, seconded by Neff.

Old Business: No landscape professionals have visited the facility to advise us on the issues with the landfill cap. On a motion by Strobehn, seconded by Juchems, the Commissioners voted to have Nelson Sager replace the window in the office at a cost of \$600. The lawnmower is currently in operable. Strobehn and Melcher will meet with Van Wahl Equipment individually to see if a 534 John Deere used mower or equivalent would be available for purchase.

Manager Brown provided the Commissioners with information and stats on garbage tonnage and fees over recent years. Due to the issues the facility has in accepting dump trailers, the Commissioners decided to leave fees for lower weights the same at \$75/ton minimum fee but increase weights for loads 1000# and over to \$100/ton.

Brown has been hauling leachate 3-4 days a week. There was discussion regarding holes in the translucent upper walls of the primary building and the need for repairs.

Melcher received a letter from the DNR regarding our application for an environmental covenant. It indicated that they are not currently issuing any permits due to the information gathering phase they are in regarding that status.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:27 on a motion by Juchems and seconded by Strobehn.
