

# Emergency Supply-Disaster Kit Checklist

**First Aid Kit:**

This kit should include enough items for your family for 72 hours (3 days) or more: bandages, anti-bacterial ointment, scissors, and non-prescription drugs (pain relievers and antacids), isopropyl alcohol.  
**\*Remember to have extra supplies for perusal of others.**

**Food & Water Supplies:**

Keep a seven day supply for each family member.  
**\*Remember to have special food for infants, babies, elderly, persons with medical conditions and pets. (Food should be non-perishable).**

Have at least one gallon of drinking water per person, per day for a seven day supply.  
**\*Remember to have additional water for pets and cooking & sanitation purposes.**

**Documents:**

Important documents (keep in waterproof holder) includes: drivers license, birth certificates, Social Security Card, passport, financial information (bank account and credit card numbers), insurance policies, money if desired, and personal will.

**Sanitation & Specialty Items:**

Sanitary supplies including: soap, moist towelettes, toilet paper, personal hygiene items, diapers, garbage bags,

Specialty items: prescribed medications, baby formula, and supplies for specific pets.

**Other Items:**

Tools and Supplies including: basic tools, battery operated radio, flashlight, extra batteries, a whistle,

Other: extra blankets, clothing, shoes, plates, cups, utensils, can opener,
