

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROCEEDINGS

The Grundy County Board of Supervisors met in regular session in the Supervisors' room on January 20, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. Chairperson Nederhoff called the meeting to order with the following members present: Schildroth, Vandehaar, and Pabst. Kopsa joined remotely.

The Board opened the meeting by reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Pabst and seconded by Vandehaar to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Carried unanimously.

Travis Case, County Recorder, presented the Recorder's December 31, 2024 Quarterly Report.

Motion was made by Schildroth and seconded by Vandehaar to accept and order filed the Grundy County Recorder's December 31, 2024 report. Carried unanimously.

Todd Rickert, Social Services, reviewed the FY2026 County General Assistance Budget.

Adam Scherling, President, Grundy County Memorial Hospital, gave an update on the hospital and reviewed the building project update, economic impact and community benefits, as well as the many awards and recognitions received by Grundy County Memorial Hospital. He was joined by Lisa Zinkula, Vice President of Finance, Grundy County Memorial Hospital, and Rick Smith, Chairperson of the Grundy County Hospital Board.

Jeff Skalberg, County Engineer, discussed department updates.

Motion was made by Schildroth and seconded by Vandehaar to approve Utility Permit 1-20-24A - Communication data link to install fiber along D Avenue from 185th St, South 0.5 miles. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Vandehaar and seconded by Pabst to approve Utility Permit 1-20-24B – Windstream to replace 25 feet of fiber around county bridge E-15 West of Wellsburg. Carried unanimously.

Joan Watson, Veterans Affairs, reviewed the Veterans Affairs FY2026 budget.

Erika Allen, County Attorney, reviewed the County Attorney's FY2026 budget.

Alan Tscherter, County Auditor, reviewed the FY2026 budgets for the Auditor, Medical Examiner, County Library, Ambulance, Domestic Animal, General Services, Non-Departmental, Juvenile Probation and Landfill.

Updates on various board and committee meetings were given.
