

## **BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROCEEDINGS**

The Grundy County Board of Supervisors met in regular session in the Supervisors' room on April 13, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. Chairperson Nederhoff called the meeting to order with the following members present: Schildroth, Kopsa, Pabst, and Vandehaar.

The Board opened the meeting by reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Pabst and seconded by Kopsa to approve the minutes of the prior meeting. Carried unanimously.

Carie Sparks, Planning & Zoning, Sanitarian, and Driver's License, discussed department matters.

Motion was made by Kopsa and seconded by Schildroth to adopt Resolution #36-2025/2026, A Resolution Accepting the Plat of Survey for Lynch Minor Subdivision. Votes on the matter were as follows: Ayes – Vandehaar, Pabst, Schildroth, Kopsa, and Nederhoff. Nays – none. Resolution adopted. Motion was made by Kopsa and seconded by Vandehaar to approve the low quote for April through September diesel fuel for Dike, Pleasant Valley, and Conrad shops from Nutrien Ag, Conrad. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Schildroth and seconded by Pabst to approve the final payment for Project L2024-BR-I11-PCI (Bridge I-11). Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Kopsa and seconded by Schildroth to approve the FY27 County Five Year Construction Plan. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Pabst and seconded by Schildroth to approve the Secondary Road FY27 Budget (IDOT). Carried unanimously.

Kirk Dolleslager, County Sheriff, discussed department matters.

Motion was made by Vandehaar and seconded by Kopsa to approve the fence project at the Sheriff's Office. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Pabst and seconded by Vandehaar to approve the Flexible Benefits Plan Document from EBS and authorize chairperson to sign the same. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Vandehaar and seconded by Schildroth to accept and order filed the Grundy County Treasurer's March 31, 2026 Monthly Investment Report. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Kopsa and seconded by Pabst to accept and order filed the Grundy County Auditor's March 31, 2026 Quarterly Report. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Vandehaar and seconded by Pabst to accept and order filed the Grundy County Recorder's March 31, 2026 Quarterly Report. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Schildroth and seconded by Kopsa to accept and order filed the Grundy County Sheriff's March 31, 2026 Quarterly Report. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Pabst and seconded by Kopsa to accept and order filed the Grundy County Veterans Affairs March 31, 2026 Quarterly Report. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Schildroth and seconded by Vandehaar to approve the request for use of Courthouse grounds for the 2026 Felix Grundy Festival. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Vandehaar and seconded by Pabst to recommend Lydia Wolken to join the Conrad Public Library Board of Trustees. Roll call vote on the matter was as follows: Ayes – Vandehaar, Pabst, Schildroth, and Nederhoff. Abstain – Kopsa. Motion carried.

Updates on various board and committee meetings were given.

There was a discussion concerning the upcoming FY27 proposed budget hearing. No action was taken.
