

## **BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROCEEDINGS**

The Grundy County Board of Supervisors met in regular session in the Supervisors' room on April 6, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. Chairperson Nederhoff called the meeting to order with the following members present: Schildroth, Kopsa, Pabst, and Vandehaar.

The Board opened the meeting by reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Vandehaar and seconded by Schildroth to approve the minutes of the prior meeting. Carried unanimously.
