

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROCEEDINGS

The Grundy County Board of Supervisors met in a regular session in the Supervisors' room at the Grundy County Courthouse on May 19, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. Chairperson Nederhoff called the meeting to order with the following members present: Vandehaar, Kopsa, and Schildroth. Pabst joined remotely.

The Board opened the meeting by reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Kopsa and seconded by Schildroth to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Pabst and seconded by Kopsa to approve the fireworks permit request for Flashing Thunder Fireworks. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Pabst and seconded by Vandehaar to approve the request for use of Courthouse grounds for Felix Grundy Days. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Kopsa and seconded by Vandehaar to reappoint Stanley Neff to the Board of Adjustment for a five-year term. Carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Schildroth and seconded by Vandehaar to reappoint Janice Hines to the Zoning Commission for a five-year term. Carried unanimously.
