

**Resolution #18-2025/2026**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors may make appropriations from the secondary road fund under section 331.429(2)(h) for assignment or designation of names or numbers to roads in the county and erection, construction or maintenance of guideposts or signs at intersections of roads in the county, and

WHEREAS, the sole source of funds for Emergency 911 Service board is the 911 surcharge to land and cellular phone lines, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 34A of the Iowa Code delineates the allowable expenditures to be made from Emergency 911 service funds which may include addressing, and


WHEREAS, the Board believes it to be in the best interests of the citizens of Grundy County that road intersection signs be maintained, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to clearly state which department is responsible for purchasing signage and maintaining the same and which department purchases address identification numbers in the county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Grundy County Board of Supervisors that from the effective date of this resolution until June 30, 2026, the director of the secondary roads department shall provide to the Emergency 911 Director a list of street intersection designation signs in the county in need or replacement along with an estimate for the cost of the signs excluding any other cost associated with their replacement. The Emergency 911 Director shall communicate with the secondary roads department to determine the number and order of signs to be replaced and the E911 service fund shall pay to the secondary roads department twenty-five percent (25%) of the cost of the signs replaced, excluding any other cost associated with their replacement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the secondary roads department shall be responsible for the purchase of all street intersection designation signs and the maintenance, repair and upkeep thereof in accordance with Iowa Code section 331.429(2)(h) from and after July 1, 2026 without additional contribution or reimbursement from the E911 service fund.
