A RESOLUTION APPROVING CHANGES TO GRUNDY COUNTY, IOWA HIPAA POLICIES & PROCEDURES.

WHEREAS, the Chief Security Officer was advised by Carosh Compliance Solutions made updates to select HIPAA policies, procedures, and forms because the federal government issued a 2024 Final Rule that aligns the confidentiality requirements for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) treatment information under 42 C.F.R. Part 2 with key elements of the HIPAA Privacy Rule, and



WHEREAS, these changes are required to be in compliance with current federal law.
